Check this before turning on the dishwasher does not heat the water anymore, why is that? Verified It is likely that the heating element is defective. Have it replaced. Verified Plastic is a bad conductor of heat, allowing the products to cool down quickly. The moisture that remains on it then evaporates far less than for example on ceramics or metal. See what the power usage of the dishwasher is, which is indicated in Watt, and check if the extension cord cn handle larger appliances.
